-Wat Phanan Choeng is one of the oldest and most important temples of Ayutthaya. It is famous all over the country, especially Luang Pho To or Chao Pho Sam Po Kong, which both Thai and Chinese Buddhists have respected and respected for a long time.  
-There is the largest temple in Ayutthaya, known for its iconic three chedis (stupas) at Wat Phra Si Sanphet. Viharn Phra Mongkol Bopit It was once part of the royal palace complex.

-Unseen at Wat Mahathat, Famous for the Buddha's head entwined in tree roots.

-Wat Yai Chai Mongkhon is known for its large reclining Buddha and the chedi that you can climb. It's an active monastery, providing a mix of historical and contemporary spiritual practices.

-Wat Lokayasutharam It is assumed that it was built in the middle Ayutthaya period. This temple has the largest reclining Buddha on the island of Ayutthaya. It is enshrined outdoors, made of bricks and cement, with a length of 42 meters and a height of 8 meters.

Return to Bangkok

Depart Ayutthaya and head back to Bangkok.

Depending on traffic and mode of transport, expect to arrive back in Bangkok by early evening.
